PENSION IMPACT NOTE

SPONSOR (S): Conroy

SYSTEM(S): IMRF

FISCAL IMPACT: HB 3908 would have unknown, though very limited fiscal impact to the state as approximately 20 people total in the state of Illinois would potentially be affected by this proposed legislation.

SUBJECT MATTER: HB 3800 amends the IMRF article of the Illinois Pension Code to restrict participation in IMRF on the part of elected officials who do not meet a specified hourly standard, or do not submit logs of time worked, and did not become a participant before the effective date of this legislation.

COMMENT: The proposed legislation would limit participation in IMRF on the part of elected/appointed officials of forest preserve districts. According to IMRF, as of 2016, 20 people in the state were potentially affected by this legislation out of 2,581 elected employees. An elected/appointed official of a forest preserve district who fails to submit time sheets or fails to conduct official government business for either 600/1000 hours (depending on applicability) with respect to that position shall not be permitted to continue participation in the pension fund. This legislation has an immediate effective date.
