FISCAL IMPACT: HB 1468 amends the Children and Family Services Act and the Juvenile Court Act of 1987 in a way that does not impact any public pension fund or retirement system in Illinois.

<u>SUBJECT MATTER</u>: HB 1468 provides that the Illinois Juvenile Justice Commission shall study and make recommendations to the General Assembly regarding the availability of youth services to reduce the use of detention and prevent deeper criminal involvement. The proposed legislation amends the Juvenile Court Act of 1987 with respect to the custody of minors believed to be delinquent minors. The bill makes other conforming changes.

COMMENT: This bill does not amend the Pension Code.
