SYSTEM(S): Downstate Firefighters

FISCAL IMPACT: HB 3354 could cause an increase in accrued liabilities to Downstate Fire pension funds to the extent the amount of survivor's pension benefits are based on a larger final salary rather than an earned pension at the time of the firefighter's death.

<u>SUBJECT MATTER</u>: HB 3354 amends the Downstate Firefighters article of the Illinois Pension Code to allow survivors of Tier 2 firefighters to receive a benefit equal to the greater of 54% of the firefighter's monthly salary at the date of death or 66 2/3% of the firefighter's earned pension at the date of death.

<u>COMMENT</u>: The proposed legislation would apply regardless of a member's active service status on or after the effective date of this legislation. This legislation has an immediate effective date and amends the State Mandates Act to require implementation without reimbursement.
