SYSTEM(S): None

FISCAL IMPACT: SB 2052, as engrossed, amends the Local Government Property Transfer Act and the Criminal Code of 2012 in a way that does not impact any pension system.

<u>SUBJECT MATTER</u>: SB 2052, as engrossed, amends the Local Government Property Transfer Act by removing a provision allowing a specified public agency to take specified actions against blighted buildings and properties. The proposed legislation removes language providing that liens for removal of dangerous or unsafe buildings are superior to tax liens. Removes examples of impairments to public health, safety, or welfare from requirements for property to be declared abandoned. Removes language barring certain hearings from being brought by individuals with a legal or equitable interest. The proposed legislation also removes an expansion to aggravated criminal housing management to include injury or death in the Criminal Code of 2012.

COMMENT: This bill does not amend the pension code.
