SYSTEM(S): Chicago Police Pension Fund

FISCAL IMPACT: The fiscal impact has not been calculated, but it would be significant.

<u>SUBJECT MATTER</u>: HB 2577 amends the Chicago Police Article of the Pension Code to increase the minimum retirement annuity from \$1,050 per month to \$1,250 per month, effective January 1, 2010. In addition, the bill increases the minimum widow's annuity from \$1,000 per month to \$1,200 per month, effective January 1, 2010.

FISCAL IMPACT: The fiscal impact has not been calculated, but it would be significant.

<u>COMMENT</u>: HB 2577 makes the following changes to the Chicago Police Article of the Pension Code:

Minimum Retirement Annuity

Currently, the minimum Chicago Police retirement annuity for members who retired at age 50 or over with at least 20 years of service is \$1,050 per month. For these retirees, HB 2577 increases the minimum monthly annuity to \$1,250 per month, effective January 1, 2010. The Chicago Firefighters' Article currently provides a minimum retirement annuity of \$1,050 per month.

Minimum Widow's Annuity

Currently, the minimum Chicago Police widow's annuity for anyone entitled to such annuity is \$1,000 per month, effective January 1, 2005. HB 2577 increases the minimum widow's annuity to \$1,200 per month for anyone entitled to such annuity, beginning January 1, 2010. The Chicago Firefighters' Article provides a minimum widow's annuity of \$1,000 per month to anyone entitled to such annuity.

HB 2577 amends the State Mandates Act to require implementation without reimbursement.
