SYSTEM(S): Chicago Police Pension Fund

FISCAL IMPACT: The fiscal impact of HB 2580 cannot be determined, as the number of officers who would recover court costs and litigation expenses is unknown. It is estimated that HB 2580 would not significantly increase the annual cost of the fund.

<u>SUBJECT MATTER</u>: HB 2580 amends the Chicago Police Article of the Pension Code to allow a prevailing police officer to recover court costs and litigation expenses, in cases during which a denial of duty disability or occupational disease disability benefits results in an action of administrative review challenging the denial of those benefits.

FISCAL IMPACT: The fiscal impact of HB 2580 cannot be determined, as the number of officers who would recover court costs and litigation expenses is unknown. It is estimated that HB 2580 would not significantly increase the annual cost of the fund.

<u>COMMENT</u>: The Chicago Police Article of the Pension Code specified that the provisions of the Administrative Review Law apply to and govern all proceedings for the judicial review of the final administrative decisions of the Fund's Board of Trustees. HB 2580 adds a further provision that allows a prevailing police officer to recover court costs and litigation expenses, in cases during which a denial of duty disability or occupational disease disability benefits results in an action of administrative review challenging the denial of those benefits.

HB 2580 amends the State Mandates Act to require implementation without reimbursement.

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
