SYSTEM(S): None

FISCAL IMPACT: HB 5295 will not impact any public pension fund or retirement system in Illinois.

SUBJECT MATTER: HB 5295 amends the Counties Code. Provides that, in counties under 3,000,000 population, a municipality is entitled to a \$25 fee (now \$10) for each conviction for a violation of the Illinois Vehicle Code or a municipal vehicle ordinance prosecuted by the municipal attorney. In counties of 3,000,000 or more population, a municipality is entitled to a \$25 fee (now \$10) for each conviction for a violation of the Illinois Vehicle Code or a municipal vehicle ordinance prosecuted by the municipal attorney

FISCAL IMPACT: HB 5295 will not impact any public pension fund or retirement system in Illinois.

COMMENT: This bill does not amend the Pension Code.
