FISCAL IMPACT: HB 6202, as amended, will have no fiscal impact on any pension funds or retirement systems in Illinois.

SUBJECT MATTER: HB 6202, as amended, amends the Electric Service Customer Choice and Rate Relief Law of 1997 in the Public Utilities Act. HB 6202, as amended, creates the Net Metering Task Force, which shall be comprised of 10 members, with one of the numbers to be named as chairperson by the Governor. HB 6202, as amended, provides that no later than January 1, 2011, the Task Force must submit a report to the General Assembly recommending legislative and programmatic changes to the existing net metering law that will be necessary to overcome existing barriers to net metering development in the State. In addition, HB 6202, as amended, states that the Illinois Commerce Commission must provide administrative support for the Task Force. It is noted that HB 6202, as amended, will neither increase nor decrease the number of judges in the State.

<u>FISCAL IMPACT</u>: HB 6202, as amended, will have no fiscal impact on any pension funds or retirement systems in Illinois.

<u>COMMENT</u>: HB 6202, as amended, does not affect any retirement system or pension fund in Illinois.

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
