BILL NO: SB 737, as amended by HA 4 January 11, 2011

SYSTEM(S): None

FISCAL IMPACT: This bill will have no discernable fiscal impact on any public pension fund or retirement system in Illinois.

<u>SUBJECT MATTER</u>: In the Riverboat Gambling Act (now, the Illinois Gambling Act), provides that the Illinois Gaming Board shall review any pledge made by a local unit of government to remit payments from the owners licensee to the State and consider a revision to that pledge if that owners licensee has experienced a significant increase in competition. Provides that a certain amount or percentage of the tax imposed on electronic gaming facilities located in the Village of Stickney and the City of Collinsville shall be distributed to the City of Berwyn (in addition to the Village of Stickney, Town of Cicero, and the Stickney Public Health District). Makes other changes.

<u>FISCAL IMPACT</u>: This bill will have no discernable fiscal impact on any public pension fund or retirement system in Illinois.

COMMENT: This bill does not amend the Pension Code.
