FISCAL IMPACT: SB 1584 will not have any fiscal impact on any pension fund or retirement system in Illinois.

<u>SUBJECT MATTER</u>: SB 1584 amends the General Assembly Article of the Illinois Pension Code. This bill seeks to add a new Section pertaining to the ramifications on an employee's pension benefits if an employee is impeached, convicted, and removed from office by the Senate. If impeached, convicted, and removed from office, the benefits provided in the Pension Code are void and will not be paid.

<u>FISCAL IMPACT</u>: SB 1584 will not have any fiscal impact on any pension fund or retirement system in Illinois.

<u>COMMENT</u>: Currently, there is no provision in the General Assembly Article of the Illinois Pension Code that specifies what happens to a employee's pension benefits if they are impeached, convicted, and removed from office by the Senate. SB 1584 would create a new provision that states if an employee is impeached, convicted, and removed from office by the Senate, they may not receive any of the benefits provided for in the General Assembly Article of the Pension Code. SB 1584 would not affect any contract acquired prior to the effective date of this Section, but all participants entering service after the effective date of this Act are deemed to have consented to this provision.
