## PENSION IMPACT NOTE

### 96TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY

BILL NO: **SB 2558**

SPONSOR (S): Koehler

SYSTEM(S): Downstate Police

---

**FISCAL IMPACT:** Persons who would be impacted by this bill would be excluded from participation in a Downstate Police fund and would accrue no service credit – therefore, SB 2558 will have no fiscal impact on the pension fund.

---

**SUBJECT MATTER:** SB 2558 amends the Downstate Police Article of the Illinois Pension Code to exclude certain municipal police officers from participating under the Downstate Police Article.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** Persons who would be impacted by this bill would be excluded from participation in a Downstate Police fund and would accrue no service credit – therefore, SB 2558 will have no fiscal impact on the pension fund.

**COMMENT:** SB 2558 seeks to provide that a person who has entered into a personal services contract to perform police duties for a municipality on or before the effective date of this amendatory Act may be appointed as an officer in the municipality within 6 months after the effective date of this amendatory Act, but said person will be excluded from participating under the Downstate Police Article of the Illinois Pension Code.
