FISCAL IMPACT: HB 1520 will have no fiscal impact on any retirement system or pension fund.

<u>SUBJECT MATTER</u>: HB 1520 amends the Code of Criminal Procedure to require a referendum on the 2012 general election ballot regarding the reestablishment of capital punishment in Illinois.

<u>FISCAL IMPACT</u>: HB 1520 will have no fiscal impact on any retirement system or pension fund.

<u>COMMENT</u>: HB 1520 requires that the following question be placed upon the 2012 general election ballot: "Should the General Assembly of the State of Illinois enact a law providing for capital punishment for first degree murder and establishing procedures for the imposition of capital punishment that are consistent with the United States Constitution as interpreted by the United States Supreme Court?" HB 1520 requires this action if and only if Senate Bill 3539 of the 96th General Assembly becomes law.
