FISCAL IMPACT: HB 3522, as amended, will have no fiscal impact on any pension funds or retirement systems in Illinois.

SUBJECT MATTER: HB 3522, as amended, amends the Illinois Vehicle Code to provide that a third or subsequent (instead of a fourth) violation of provisions prohibiting driving while under the influence of alcohol, other drugs, intoxicating compound or compounds or any combination thereof that results in the death of another person is a Class X (instead of a Class 1) felony. HB 3522, as amended, provides that if the violation resulted in the deaths of 2 or more persons, the defendant will be sentenced to a term of imprisonment of not less than 10 years and not more than 45 years. HB 3522, as amended, amends the Unified Code of Corrections to provide that a defendant shall receive no good conduct credit and must serve the entire sentence imposed by the court.

<u>FISCAL IMPACT</u>: HB 3522, as amended, will have no fiscal impact on any pension funds or retirement systems in Illinois.

<u>COMMENT</u>: HB 3522, as amended, does not affect any retirement system or pension fund in Illinois.
