## PENSION IMPACT NOTE

### 97TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY

BILL NO: **SB 1853, as Engrossed** April 29, 2011

**FISCAL IMPACT:** SB 1853 will not impact any public pension fund or retirement system in Illinois.

---

**SUBJECT MATTER:** SB 1853, as engrossed, provides that, if the police department of any city, town, or county investigates abandoned cremated remains and cannot locate the owner of the cremated remains that are also considered as human remains, then the police shall deliver such human remains to the coroner, and the coroner shall cause the human remains to be disposed of as otherwise provided in provisions of that Act. Amends the Cemetery Oversight Act

**FISCAL IMPACT:** SB 1853 will not impact any public pension fund or retirement system in Illinois.

**COMMENT:** This bill does not amend the Pension Code.
