FISCAL IMPACT: This bill will not impact any public pension fund or retirement system in Illinois.

<u>SUBJECT MATTER</u>: Reinserts the provisions of the Bill. Changes penalties for aggravated unlawful use of a weapon. Provides that it is an affirmative defense to the offense of aggravated unlawful use of a weapon for not holding a currently valid Firearm Owner's Identification Card that the defendant has, prior to the commission of the offense, submitted a Firearm Owner's Identification Card renewal application to the Department of State Police and the defendant is otherwise eligible for a Firearm Owner's Identification Card.

FISCAL IMPACT: This bill will not impact any public pension fund or retirement system in Illinois.

COMMENT: HB 2265, as amended by HA 1, does not amend the Pension Code.
