FISCAL IMPACT: There is no discernible fiscal impact of any pension

system associated with HB 5569, as amended by HA 1.

<u>SUBJECT MATTER</u>: Replaces everything after the enacting clause with the introduced bill and changes the short title of the Act to the Youth Mental Health Protection Act. Adds provisions regarding the General Assembly's findings and provides that the purpose of the Act is to protect lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender youth from sexual orientation change efforts (rather than to prohibit the use of sexual orientation change efforts by mental health providers). Provides that a mental health provider shall not refer a client or patient to any individual for the purpose of sexual orientation change efforts and that a mental health provider who is found to have referred a client or patient shall be subject to discipline.

<u>FISCAL IMPACT</u>: There is no discernible fiscal impact of any pension system associated with HB 5569, as amended by HA 1.

<u>COMMENT</u>: HB 5569, as amended by HA 1, contains no language directly or indirectly affecting the state of being of any pension system nor members, active or retired, of any pension system within Illinois.
