<u>SUBJECT MATTER</u>: HB 1456 amends the State Universities Article of the Illinois Pension Code by making a number of technical changes.

## **COMMENT:**

<u>Technical Change #1:</u> Adds a statutory reference to direct readers to the definition of service.

<u>Technical Change #2:</u> Defines the "plan year" as being July 1 through June 30<sup>th</sup> of the next calendar year.

<u>Technical Change #3:</u> In a section regarding the reinstatement of credit after returning a refund, changes the interest to start compounding on the date of issuance of refund instead of the date of reception of the refund.

<u>Technical Change #4:</u> Allows only active participants to use employer pickup to buy extra service credit; however, inactive participants are now empowered to purchase service credit.
