SYSTEM(S): Chicago Firefighters

FISCAL IMPACT: According to the Chicago Firefighters' Pension Fund, HB 6297 is projected to have a positive fiscal impact. An actuarial study is currently underway to determine the extent of the impact and a revised impact note will be issued upon completion.

<u>SUBJECT MATTER</u>: HB 6297 proposes that the spouse of a firefighter, who perishes due to an illness or injury that is unrelated to any illness or injury that he or she is receiving disability benefits for, will not receive an annuity.

<u>COMMENT</u>: HB 6297 amends the Chicago Firefighters' Article of the Illinois Pension code by clarifying that the spouse of a firefighter, who dies while in receipt of disability benefits when his or her death was caused by an intervening illness or injury unrelated to the illness or injury that had prevented him or her from subsequently resuming active service in the fire department, shall not receive payment of a surviving spouse annuity.
