SPONSOR(S): Biss

SYSTEM(S): State Universities Retirement System (SURS)

FISCAL IMPACT: There is no discernible fiscal impact associated with SB 777.

<u>SUBJECT MATTER</u>: SB 777 amends the State Universities Article of the Illinois Pension Code by making a number of technical changes.

## COMMENT:

**Technical Change #1:** Adds a statutory reference to direct readers to the definition of service.

<u>Technical Change #2:</u> Defines the "plan year" as being July 1 through June  $30^{th}$  of the next calendar year.

**Technical Change #3:** In a section regarding the reinstatement of credit after returning a refund, changes the interest to start compounding on the date of issuance of refund instead of the date of reception of the refund.

**<u>Technical Change #4</u>:** Allows only active participants to use employer pickup to buy extra service credit; however, inactive participants are now empowered to purchase service credit.

\*SB 777 is identical to HB 1456 (Nekritz).
