FISCAL IMPACT: HB 318, as amended by HA #2, will not impact any public pension fund or retirement system in Illinois.

<u>SUBJECT MATTER</u>: HB 318, as amended by H A #2, amends the Consumer Fraud and Deceptive Business Practices Act. The bill restores the language allowing any utility service providers to divulge the listed personal information to credit bureaus without the written consent of the subscriber. The bill also provides that credit bureaus that receive personal consumer information from a utility service provider may not use that information to determine credit scores.

FISCAL IMPACT: HB 318, as amended by HA #2, will not impact any public pension fund or retirement system in Illinois.

COMMENT: HB 318, as amended by HA #2, does not amend the Pension Code.
