SYSTEM(S): Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund

FISCAL IMPACT: The impact of HB 0804 cannot be determined as the number of members who will purchase military service credit is unknown.

SUBJECT MATTER: HB 0804 amends the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund article of the Pension Code to allow certain members to purchase up to 4 years of creditable service for service in the armed forces of the United States.

FISCAL IMPACT: The impact of HB 0804 cannot be determined as the number of members who will purchase military service credit is unknown.

COMMENT: HB 0804 allows members of IMRF to purchase up to 4 years of service credit for military service. The member is required to; apply to IMRF in writing and provide evidence of the military service that is satisfactory to the Board; obtain the written approval of the current employer; and make the employer and employer contributions (normal cost), plus interest from the date of first membership to the date of payment. If payment is made during the 6 month period that begins one month after the effective date of the Amendatory Act, the required interest shall be 2.5% per year, compounded annually. Otherwise, the required interest shall be calculated at the regular interest rate.

HB 0804 amends the State Mandates Act to require implementation without reimbursement.
