PENSION IMPACT NOTE

95TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY

BILL NO: **HB 1421, as amended by HA #2** April 25, 2007

SPONSOR (S): Nekritz – Boland, et al

SYSTEM(S): None

FISCAL IMPACT: HB 1421, as amended by HA #2, will not impact any public pension fund or retirement system in Illinois.

SUBJECT MATTER: HB 1421, as amended by HA #2, provides that beginning January 1, 2011 (instead of January 1, 2008), a person may not manufacture, process, or knowingly sell, offer for sale, distribute for sale, or distribute for use a mattress, mattress pad, an article of furniture, or any other product intended for indoor residential use if the product has a textile component containing decaBDE. The bill, as amended, provides that a manufacturer of a certain products restricted under the Act must notify persons that sell or distribute the manufacturer's product of the requirements of the Act no later than January 1, 2008 (instead of no later than 90 days prior to the effective date of the restriction).

FISCAL IMPACT: HB 1421, as amended by HA #2, will not impact any public pension fund or retirement system in Illinois.

COMMENT: HB 1421, as amended by HA #2, does not amend the Pension Code.
