**FISCAL IMPACT:** HB 1958 will not impact any public pension fund or retirement system in Illinois.

---

**SUBJECT MATTER:** HB 1958 amends the Consumer Fraud and Deceptive Business Practices Act. The bill provides that the new provisions may be cited as the Cell Phone Lemon Law. If, within the period of a contract for wireless telephone service, a wireless telephone sold in conjunction with a contract for wireless telephone service requires repair or replacement on 3 or more occasions, the consumer may, in lieu of having the telephone repaired or replaced on the third or subsequent occasion: choose to cancel the contract for wireless telephone service without paying any early termination fee, penalty, or charge; or elect to upgrade or downgrade the telephone in accordance with specified provisions.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** HB 1958 will not impact any public pension fund or retirement system in Illinois.

**COMMENT:** HB 1958 does not amend the Pension Code.
