FISCAL IMPACT: The fiscal impact of SB 0153 cannot be determined as the number of teachers who may wish to purchase optional service credit for pregnancy leaves of absence is unknown. The bill requires the teacher to pay the employer's normal cost and the employee contribution, plus interest, from the date of service to the date of payment. Therefore, the cost should be minimal.

<u>SUBJECT MATTER</u>: SB 0153 amends the Downstate Teachers Article of the Illinois Pension Code to grant service credit to any teacher for a leave of absence during which a teacher ceases covered employment due to pregnancy.

<u>FISCAL IMPACT</u>: The fiscal impact of SB 0153 cannot be determined as the number of teachers who may wish to purchase optional service credit for pregnancy leaves of absence is unknown. The bill requires the teacher to pay the employer's normal cost and the employee contribution, plus interest, from the date of service to the date of payment. Therefore, the cost should be minimal.

<u>COMMENTS</u>: Currently, the Illinois Pension Code lists specific periods of service for which a member may purchase optional service credit. SB 0153 amends the Downstate Teacher Article of the Pension Code to add pregnancy leaves of absence to this approved list. Members are required to provide satisfactory evidence for the leave and to pay all contributions as of the date specified. In addition, SB 0153 states that allowing teachers to establish service credit for a pregnancy leave of absence constitutes a new benefit increase, and this increase shall be funded by the additional employee contributions.

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
