SYSTEM(S): None

FISCAL IMPACT: SB 0572, as engrossed, will not impact any public pension fund or retirement system in Illinois.

<u>SUBJECT MATTER</u>: SB 0572, as engrossed, amends the Illinois Vehicle Code to provide that an offender's eligibility for a restricted driving permit depends on whether denial of all driving privileges would cause undue hardship, as defined by rules adopted by the Secretary of State. The bill also provides that a person convicted of 4 or more offenses of driving under the influence, leaving the scene of an accident involving death or personal injury, or reckless homicide, or a combination of those offenses, is not eligible for a restricted driving permit. Makes other changes.

<u>FISCAL IMPACT</u>: SB 0572, as engrossed, will not impact any public pension fund or retirement system in Illinois.

COMMENT: SB 0572, as engrossed, does not amend the Pension Code.
