## ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FACILITY CLOSURE TENTATIVE TIMEFRAME

The Illinois Department of Transportation notified the Commission on Government Forecasting and Accountability that the Department was closing the facility located at **3215 Executive Drive in Springfield, Illinois** in a correspondence received on May 5<sup>th</sup>, 2008. The State Facility Closure Act (30 ILCS 608) allows the Commission discretion as to whether a recommendation for closure is warranted. The State Facility Closure Act has specific time frames in which requirements of the act must be met. Below is a timeline showing specific dates for the closure process of the Department of Transportation facility located at **3215 Executive Drive in Springfield, Illinois**.

- ✉ **(Initial Announcement Date)** *The Department of Transportation notified the Commission of the intent to close the facility at 3215 Executive Drive in Springfield, Illinois on May 5<sup>th</sup>, 2008.*
- ✉ **(10 Days) May 19<sup>th</sup>, 2008** *the Commission requests recommendation for closure.*
- ✉ **(30 Days) July 1st, 2008** *deadline for recommendation from the Department of Transportation.*
- ✉ **(30 Days) A public comment period from July 2nd-August 13th, 2008.** *The State Facilities Closure Act does not require a public hearing on this closure.*
- ✉ **(35 Days) July 2<sup>nd</sup>-August 20<sup>th</sup>, 2008.** *The Commission may have a public hearing during this time frame. This hearing must take place within a twenty-five mile radius of the Department of Transportation facility.*
- ✉ **(50 Days) September 11th, 2008.** *Deadline for the Commission to issue an advisory opinion.*

The timeline above is based on business days excluding weekends and holidays. Should the Department of Transportation supply the Commission with a recommendation prior to the statutorily required 30 day period, the timeline would be adjusted to reflect any changes.
