SYSTEM(S): Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund

FISCAL IMPACT: The number of potentially affected individuals as a result of HB 4599 is unknown. As a result, the financial impact cannot be determined.

<u>SUBJECT MATTER</u>: HB 4599 proposes that full-time paramedics, and various classes of Emergency Technicians as outlined below, that are not eligible to participate in a Downstate Firefighter pension fund, may be approved for SLEP status in IMRF.

<u>COMMENT</u>: HB 4599 amends the IMRF Article of the Illinois Pension Code. It grants IMRF Sheriff's Law Enforcement Employees (SLEP) status to a person who:

- Is not eligible to participate in a Downstate Firefighter pension fund
- Is employed on a full-time basis by a participating municipality to perform duties such as:
 - o Paramedic
 - o Emergency Medical Technician (EMT)
 - o Emergency Medical Technician-Intermediate (EMT-I)
 - o Advanced Emergency Medical Technician (A-EMT)
- Has received approval for SLEP status by the governing authority of that municipality by adoption of affirmative resolution.
