FISCAL IMPACT: An actuarial cost study from the pension fund would be necessary to assess the fiscal impact of SB 2525. An updated note will be submitted when such a study has been made available.

\_\_\_\_\_

<u>SUBJECT MATTER</u>: SB 2525 proposes that 3% COLAs for certain Chicago police officers be compounded beginning with the effective date of this bill.

<u>COMMENT</u>: SB 2525 amends the Chicago Police Article of the Illinois Pension Code. It provides that any 3% COLA shall be compounded beginning with the first COLA following attainment of age 75 for a police officer who:

- Retires after September 1, 1967
- Has at least 20 years of service
- Is at least 75 years of age

For police officers who met the above criteria prior to the passing of this bill, their COLAs will compound beginning after this bill becomes law.
