PENSION IMPACT NOTE

BILL NO: **HB 3761, House Amendment 1**

SPONSOR(S): McAsey – Hernandez, et al.

SYSTEM(S): None

FISCAL IMPACT: There is no discernible fiscal impact of any pension system associated with HB 3761, as amended by HA 1.

SUBJECT MATTER: HB 3761, as amended by HA 1, amends the Children's Product Safety Act. Prohibits a commercial dealer, manufacturer, importer, distributor, wholesaler, or retailer from selling, offering to sell, leasing, or offering to lease a crib bumper pad in the State. This bill imposes a civil penalty of not less than \$100 and not more than \$500 for each violation. This amendment includes a definition of "Crib Bumper Pads."

COMMENT: HB 3761, as amended by HA 1, contains no language directly or indirectly affecting the state of being of any pension system nor members, active or retired, of any pension system within Illinois.
