PENSION IMPACT NOTE

SYSTEM(S): State Universities' Retirement System

FISCAL IMPACT: The fiscal impact of HB 0823 cannot be calculated, as

the amount of additional service credit that would be established for unused sick leave is unknown. There would be a fiscal impact, however, as employees establishing the service credit are not required to make any contributions for that credit.

<u>SUBJECT MATTER</u>: HB 0823 amends the State Universities Article of the Illinois Pension Code to allow members to establish service credit for up to two years (rather than one) of unused and uncompensated sick leave.

<u>FISCAL IMPACT</u>: The fiscal impact of HB 0823 cannot be calculated, as the amount of additional service credit that would be established for unused sick leave is unknown. There would be a fiscal impact, however, as employees establishing the service credit are not required to make any contributions for that credit.

<u>COMMENT</u>: Currently, member of SURS may establish up to one year of service credit for unused and uncompensated sick leave. Only sick leave earned in accordance with the employer's sick leave accrual policy (applicable to all employees or a class of employees) is taken into account when determining the amount of sick leave service credit that may be established. HB 0823 increases the amount of sick leave service credit that may be established to two years, based on the following schedule:

Members of SERS may establish service credit for all periods of unused and uncompensated sick leave, without limit. No employee contributions are required. TRS members may establish up to two years of service credit for unused and uncompensated sick leave without making contributions.
