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I. POPULATION TOTALS

- In the past decade, the United States resident population grew 13.2%, reaching 281,421,906 in 2000. (See Chart 1). At the same time, Illinois grew at a more modest, yet substantial, rate of 8.6% to reach a total of 12,419,293.
- As a result of these disparate growth rates, Illinois' population now accounts for 4.4% of the nation, down from 4.6% in the 1990 census.
- A shifting population base has caused a reapportionment of the U.S. House of Representatives for the 108th Congress. As shown in Chart 2, Illinois will lose 1 seat in the House. This is reflective of slower growth in the Midwest with Wisconsin, Michigan, Indiana, and Ohio each losing 1 seat, while Pennsylvania and New York each lose 2 seats. Biggest gainers, with 2 House seats each, are Arizona, Texas, Georgia, and Florida.
- Illinois now will have 19 representatives, down from 20 in 1990, or 4.4% of the 435 representatives in the U.S. House of Representatives for the 108th Congress. Table 1 shows the number of apportioned representatives by state based on Census 2000 and the change from 1990 census apportionment.
- Population density also has changed throughout the State in the past decade. Chart 3 shows the 2000 Census total population by county, Chart 4 shows the change in total population by county from 1990 to 2000, and Chart 5 shows the percent change in population by county in the past decade.
- After declining by more than 220,000 between 1980 and 1990, population in the City of Chicago rose 4%, or 112,000, to 2.9 million in the 2000 census.
- Table 2 lists the 10 largest counties; the 10 fastest growing counties; the 10 largest cities in Illinois; and the 10 fastest growing cities over the past decade.

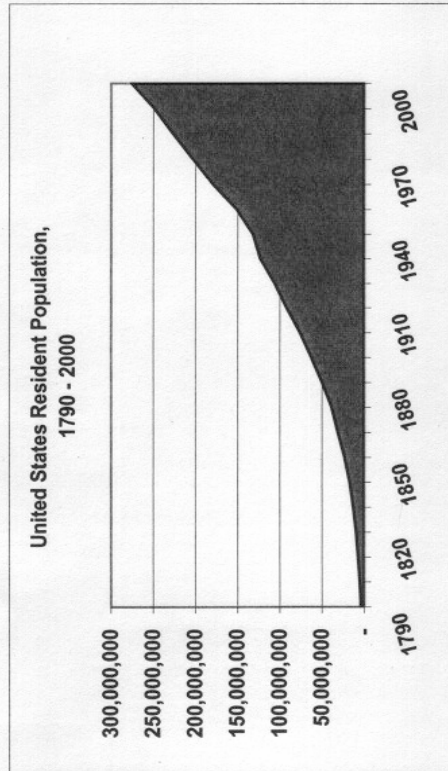

Apportionment of the U.S. House of Representatives for the 108th Congress

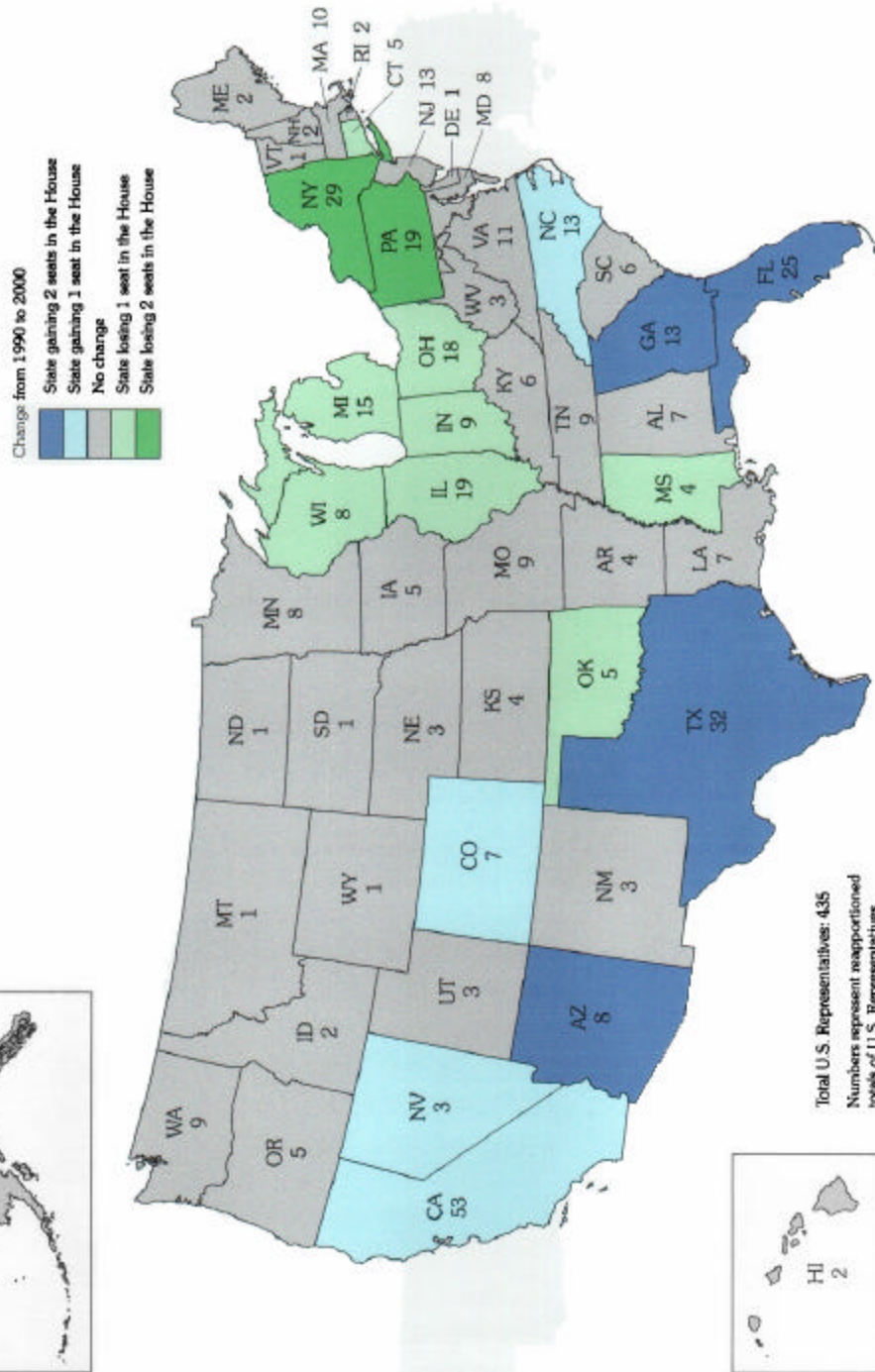

2000 Census Total Population by County

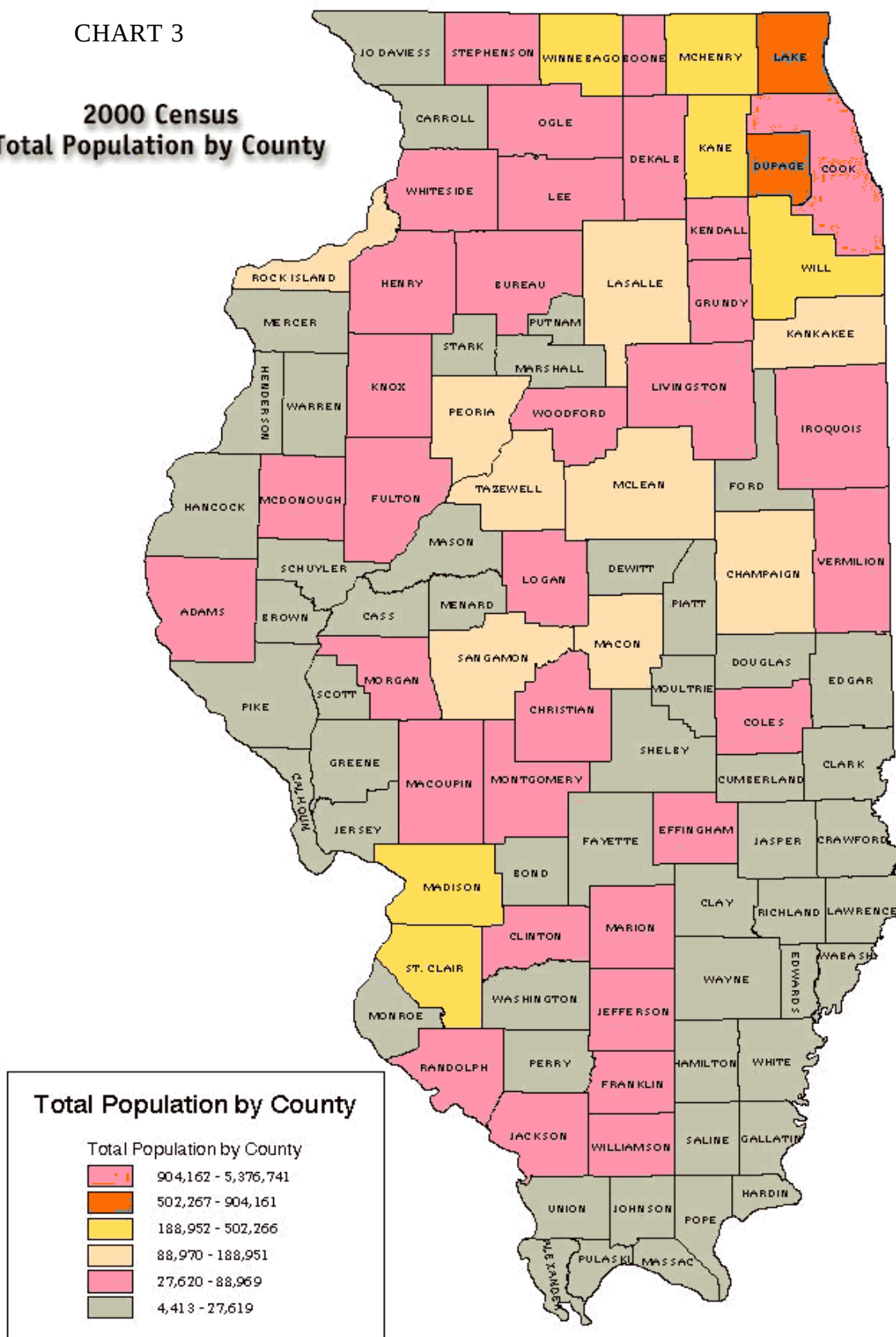

Total Population by County Change from 1990 to 2000

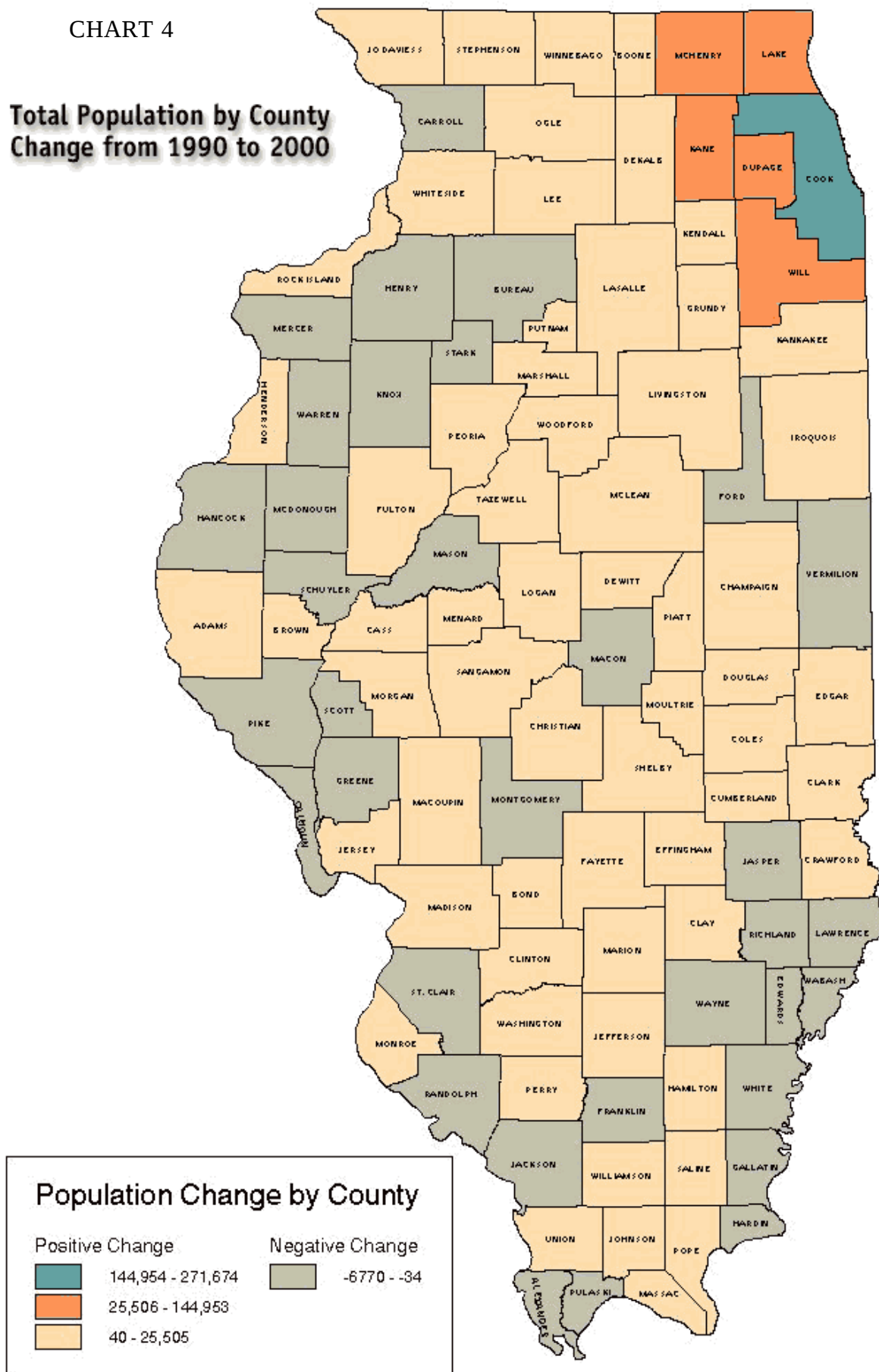

1990 to 2000**

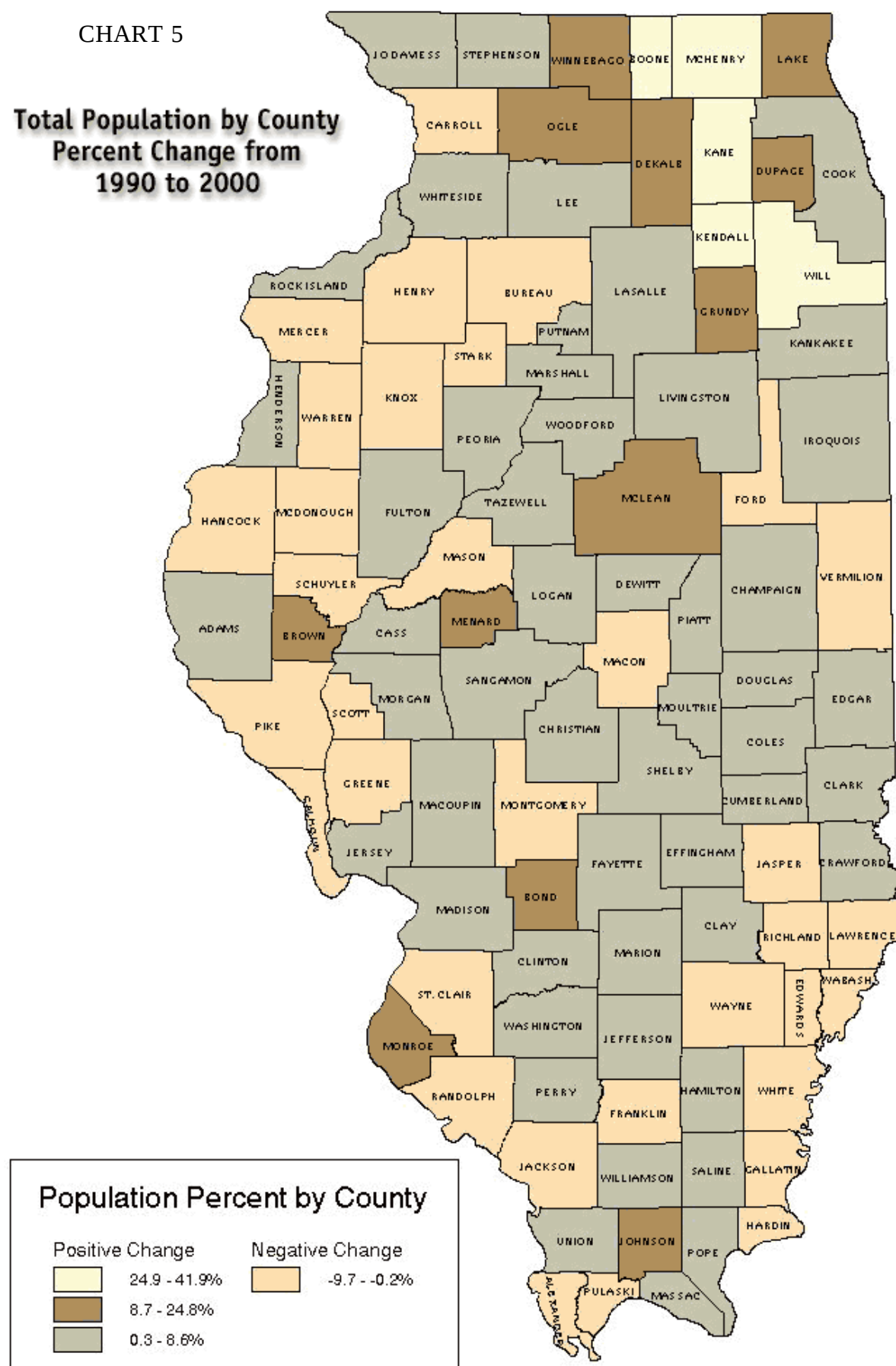

II. POPULATION DIVERSITY

- The State of Illinois has become more diverse in its population mix over the past decade, according to the 2000 Census.
- By race, the White or Caucasian race now accounts for 73.5% of the State, down from 78.3% in 1990. Black or African American's share rose from 14.8% in 1990 to 15.1% in 2000 while those classified as Asian rose from a 2.5% share to 3.4%.
- The largest recorded shift was in the Hispanic or Latino group, now accounting for 12.3% of Illinois' population, up sharply from 7.9% ten years earlier.
- Chart 6 shows the Hispanic or Latino population by county while Chart 7 illustrates the per cent change by county over the past decade in the Hispanic or Latino population.
- The number of households in Illinois (families) has declined in relative terms over the past 10 years, with married-couple families falling in importance while nonfamily households and households living alone have increased.
- Married-couple families fell from 54.1% of total households in 1990 to 51.3% in 2000 while the nonfamily households share rose to 32.4% from 30.4%. Female households with no husband present rose to 12.3% in 2000 from 12.0% in 1990.
- Home ownership also has increased sharply. Owner-occupied housing units made up 67.3% of housing in the State in 2000, up from 64.2% in 1990. Rentals dropped from 35.8% to 32.7% over the last decade.
- Table 3 and 4 present a profile of general demographics characteristics for Illinois for census years 1990 and 2000.

2000 Census Hispanic or Latino Population by County

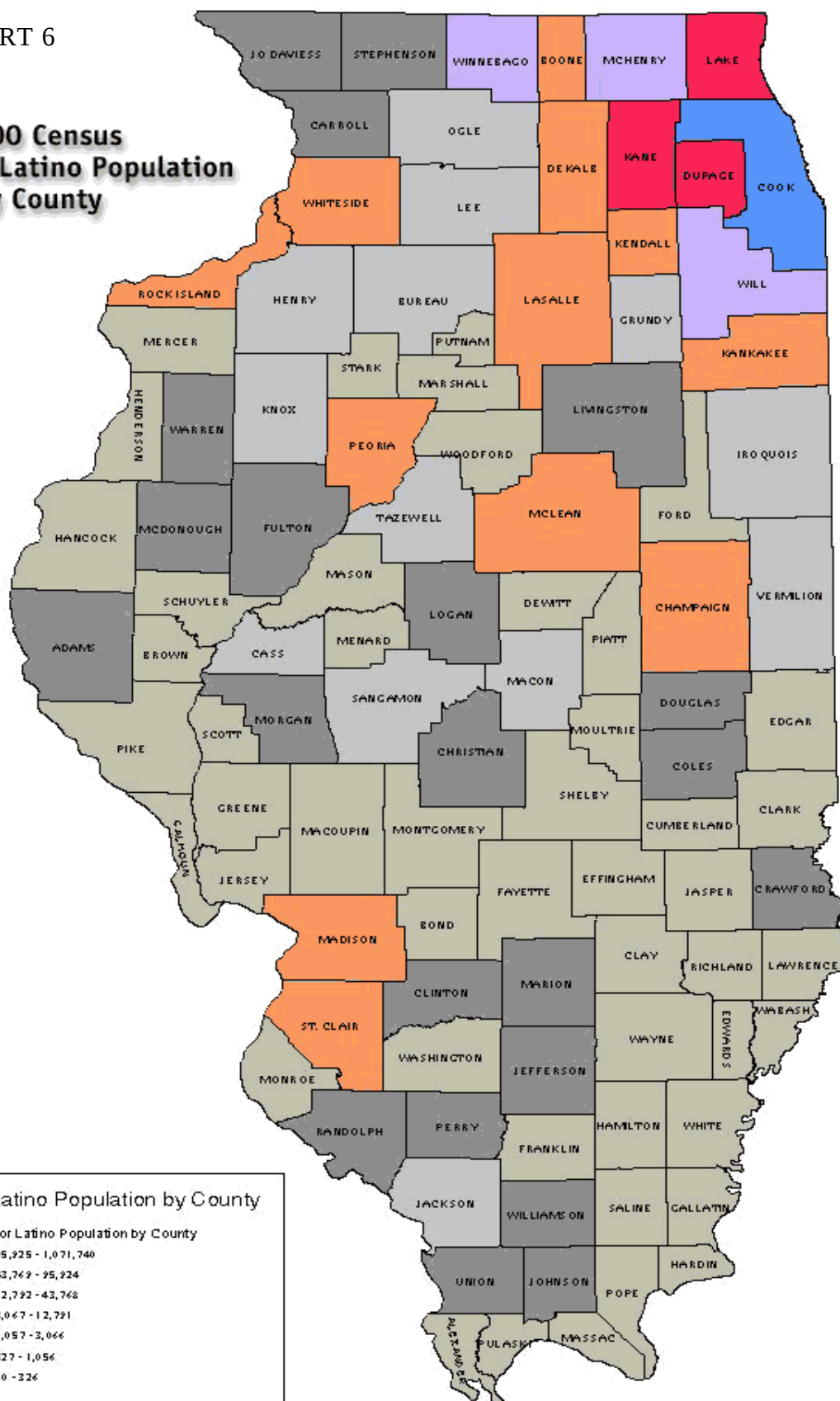
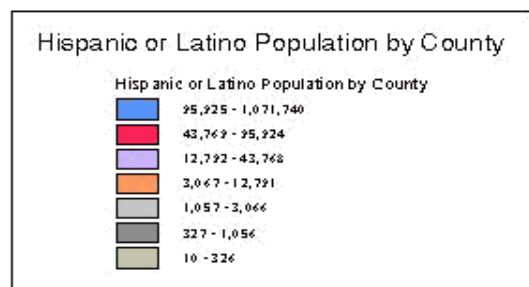

Hispanic or Latino Population by County Percent Change from 1990 to 2000

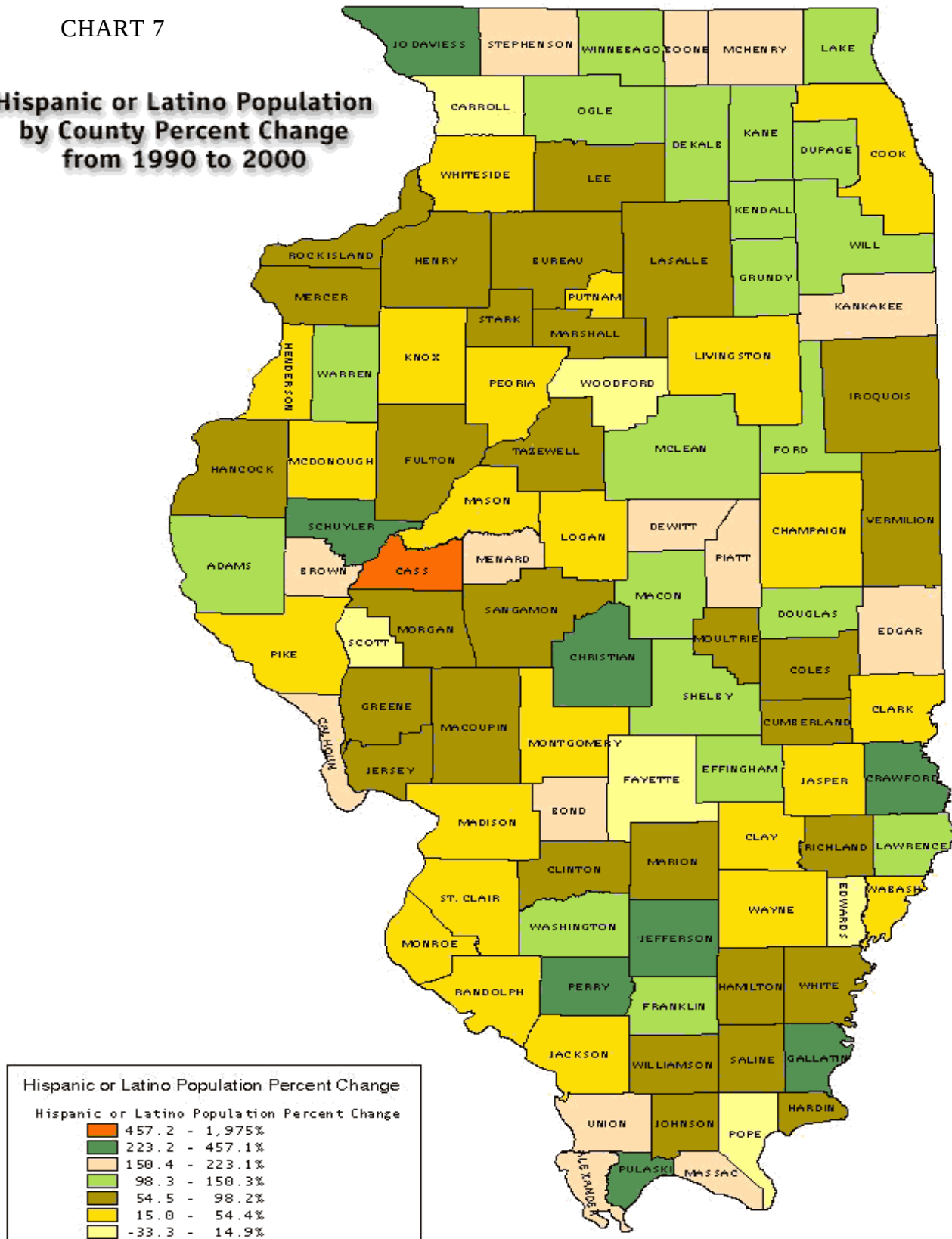

III. INCOME AND POVERTY LEVELS

- Medium household income rose in the Midwest and South, rising to \$42,700 in 1999, compared to a national figure of \$40,800. (See Table 5).
- Per-capita income was \$32,259 in Illinois in 2000, up 55% from \$20,756 in 1990. Personal income on a per-capita basis for the U.S. as a whole was \$29,676 in 2000, up 51% from \$19,584 in 1990.
- Illinois gained in per-capita personal income, ranking 9th in the United States in 2000, up from its 10th position in both 1980 and 1990.
- Even so, income distribution was not equally spread throughout the State. Table 6 shows per-capita income by county, change in the past year, and rank in the State.
- The percent of persons in poverty has been on the decline in recent years. As shown in Table 4, the percent of people listed in poverty fell to 12.3% in 1999 from 13% in 1998 and averaged 12.6% in the 1997-99 period.
- In Illinois, the percent of persons in poverty fell to 10% in 1999, down from 10.6% in 1998 and a three-year average of 10.4%.
- Poverty thresholds are adjusted each year and vary by size of family and number of related children under 18 years of age. In 1999, the poverty threshold was \$8,667 for one person, \$10,869 for two people, \$17,029 for four, etc. See Table 7 for poverty threshold by size of family.

BACKGROUND

The Illinois Economic and Fiscal Commission, a bipartisan, joint legislative commission, provides the General Assembly with information relevant to the Illinois economy, taxes and other sources of revenue and debt obligations of the State. The Commission's specific responsibilities include:

- 1) Preparation of annual revenue estimates with periodic updates;
- 2) Analysis of the fiscal impact of revenue bills;
- 3) Preparation of "State Debt Impact Notes" on legislation which would appropriate bond funds or increase bond authorization;
- 4) Periodic assessment of capital facility plans; and
- 5) Annual estimates of the liabilities of the State's group health insurance program and approval of contract renewals promulgated by the Department of Central Management Services.

The Commission also has a mandate to report to the General Assembly ". . . on economic trends in relation to long-range planning and budgeting; and to study and make such recommendations as it deems appropriate on local and regional economic and fiscal policies and on federal fiscal policy as it may affect Illinois. . . ." This results in several reports on various economic issues throughout the year.

The Commission publishes two primary reports. The "Revenue Estimate and Economic Outlook" describes and projects economic conditions and their impact on State revenues. "The Illinois Bond Watcher" examines the State's debt position as well as other issues directly related to conditions in the financial markets. The Commission also periodically publishes special topic reports that have or could have an impact on the economic well being of Illinois.
